Pro Am Challenge Cup

This trophy was presented to the SGC in 1971 by C K Linney, a past Captain of The Nevill and, in 1971, of the SGC, and is awarded each year to the amateur team achieving the lowest score whilst playing in the Pro-Am Tournament. Past Winners are shown in the following table. This is a very old trophy, demonstrated by the engraving on the reverse. Previously entitled The Tradesmans Cup, it shows the winners as G Harcourt in 1895 and F Rossiter in 1896, 1897 and 1898. The very first Pro Am was held at Bognor Regis Golf Club in 1970. In 1974 it became a members only event and in 1976 played in the format it is now.

Pro Am Perpetual Challenge Cup

This trophy was presented to the SGC in 1970 by JH Langmead, a past Captain of Littlehampton and, in 1969, of the SGC, and is awarded each year to the professional who achieves the lowest individual score whilst playing in the Pro-Am Tournament.

The current team format of three Captains inviting a club Professional started in 1991.

The aforementioned President's Trophy was stolen and missing for several years until it was discovered for sale in an antique shop in Burford. It was returned to its rightful owners in 1993. This probably explains why the trophies have been spilt up.

Ken Bristow, a past Captain of Royal Ashdown and, in 1968, of the SGC, presented these two silver half pint tankards at the end of his year as Captain. Engraved Dinner Foursomes they were first played for at The Dyke Golf Club in 1969 before the annual dinner, which was held at the Dudley Hotel in Hove. The competition that precedes the annual dinner is now a better ball event.
